## I. PURPOSE:

To establish procedures for awarding dual credit to students who are enrolled in college courses while attending high school.

## II. PERSONNEL AFFECTED:

- A. Building Administrators
- **B.** All Certificated Personnel
- C. Eligible High School Students

## III. PROCEDURES:

- A. Students wishing to take a college course shall make this request to the building principal the semester prior to enrollment in the course.
- B. Students may enroll in a college course if that course is not offered at their attendance center or if the building principal grants an exception.
- C. Dual credit may be approved by the building principal for college courses taken at an accredited institution. If dual credit is elected to be taken as credit/no credit, it is to be in accordance with all provisions in Administrative Regulation No. 6150-1. Grades earned in dual credit college courses can be used in the calculation of the student's high school grade point average.
- D. One-half (.5) high school unit may be awarded for successful completion of at least a three-hour credit college course. A student wishing to earn more than 7.5 high school units through 15 college hours in one semester must obtain prior principal approval.
- E. A committee established by the Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning will review and approve the list of approved college courses and the awarding high school credits.
