I. PURPOSE:

To establish procedures and guidelines for securing Special Services intervention and continuing Child Find activities.

II. STUDENT RESOURCE TEAM MEETING:

- A. Each building principal shall establish a student resource team. The composition of this team may include but not be limited to: the student's teacher(s), the principal, and the counselor. Other personnel, such as the social worker, resource teacher, school psychologist, speech clinician, or other support staff may be a member of the committee as determined by the building principal. This team will serve to:
 - 1.Review on a regular basis students that may require the services of special education:
 - 2. Continue "Child Find" efforts; and
 - 3. Serve as the forum to develop, evaluate, modify, and document general education interventions.
- B. The initial step in referring a student to this team is the observation and documentation of the student's difficulty by a certified employee and/or instructional paraprofessional.
- C. It is the responsibility of the employee mentioned above (B.) to make every effort to remediate the problem and/or document educational alternatives in the regular education program.
- D. It is the building principal's responsibility to ensure that the child's cumulative records are made available to this team.
- E. This team may make additional suggestions on remediating the problem in the regular class setting.
