PARENT CONFERENCES/REPORTING TO PARENTS

Strengthening communication with parents is a priority of the Board of Education. Quarterly reports of pupil progress will be made to parents. Parent conferences will be scheduled in conjunction with the first and third report to parents. In addition to conventional communication with parents, schools shall provide information in a variety of formats, help parents access information on PowerSchool, and assist parents in understanding their role in preparing their children to be college and career ready. The District shall periodically review the effectiveness of communication with parents and make adjustments to ensure all students and parents have meaningful access to information on an equitable basis, including access to interpreters or written translated materials.
